## IS HEALING FOR TODAY?

With so much Pharmacia available today it is understandable why one goes to the store for a medical cure. But what does Jesus say? "By His stripes you are healed," Is 53: 4-5, 1Pet. 2:24. He paid a huge price for our healing, and though we seek relief elsewhere we are not cured by medicine.

First, we must decide is God's Word true. He is King of this Universe and gave us an instructional manual on how He wanted us to live and serve Him. In the Bible when a king makes a decree it stands and cannot be broken, and these were mere men. So the idea here is to believe the Word of Elohim.
